Nevada-Utah Conference Grading Policy

It is the goal of the faculty in this school to provide you, the parent, with as much information as possible to help you better support your student. To that end here is the grading policy.

As student work is graded it will receive a letter grade. It will be assigned as follows:

Grades !-8 Grades 9-12

90% Correct or better = A 92% Correct or better = A

80% - 89% Correct = B 84% - 91% Correct = B

70% - 79% Correct = C 76% - 83% Correct = C

60% - 69% Correct = D 68% - 75% Correct = D

Less than 60% Correct = F Less than 67% Correct = F

Each teacher will have the discretion on whether to provide extra credit assignments. They will also decide how and on what basis incorrect work will be corrected.

LATE AND MISSING ASSIGNMENTS

Students should be encouraged to make sure all work is turned in complete and on time. If a student misses school due to an excused absence they will have as many days as they were absent to turn in their assignments without penalty. For example if they are absent 3 days, after returning to school they have 3 days to turn in the back assignments.

For work that is late without excuses the penalty will be a loss of 10% in grade for each day the assignment is late. For example: if an assignment with 90% or better correct is one day late the best grade it would receive would be a 80%. If it were 2 days late the best grade it would receive would be a 70% and so on.
